Cumrew is a small village and civil parish in north-east Cumbria. It was historically part of Cumberland. Cumrew consists of two townships one of which is Cumrew Inside and the other Cumrew outside. Together they contain 2,686 acres. The parish borders Croglin, Cumwhitton, Carlatten, and Castle Carrock. The Church is dedicated to St Mary, built in 1890 and designed by George Dale Oliver.
