High Head was a chapelry in the parish of Dalston, ward and county of Cumberland. It is situated on the Ive Beck water in Inglewood Forest. On the brow of a rocky eminence are the ruins of Highhead Castle (Manor House), formerly held by the Harclas, Dacres, and L'Englises., The first known occupants of the house were the Richmond family who bought and extended the house in the 16th century.
