Kirkland is a village in the Eden District, in the English county of Cumbria, historically in Cumberland. It is situated near the river Eden, under Cross Fell, and contains the townships of Skirwith and Blencarn, and the chapelry of Culgaith. The church is dedicated to St Lawrence and is believed to date from the 13th Century although extensively restored and enlarged in the 19th Century. It is said to have been much larger in medieval times when the parish included Skirwith and Culgaith.
